Take time to pray as a church, prepare your heart asking God for a burden for the lost, and for the outreach ahead.

# PRAYER

Prayer is the foundation of all evangelism. Ask God to open hearts, provide wisdom, and give boldness to step into conversations. As a leader, model this behavior for your church, showing them that prayer isn't just part of evangelism—it's the heart of it.

Instruct your church to pray for one specific person or group they can reach out to on GO Day. Encourage them to ask the Holy Spirit for guidance and to open doors for meaningful conversations.

Dave G always prays for BOB each morning. Asking God to give him a Burden for the lost, Opportunities to reach out, and Boldness in sharing the Gospel.

As you prepare for GO Day, guide your church or small group in learning how to effectively share their personal story and testimony.

# YOU CAN APPROACH THIS IN THREE WAYS:

- 1. Set aside 20 minutes during a Sunday service or gathering for believers to write down their testimonies, answer the three questions below, and share them with a partner sitting next to them.
- **2.** Devote an entire Sunday message to this topic. (I have attached a possible message to this email.)
- **3.** Encourage your church to reflect on their own stories and guide them with questions like:
  - How was your life before you met Jesus?
  - How did Jesus come into your life? What happened during that moment?
  - What has changed since you started following Him?



# THE FOUR SYMBOLS

Use simple tools to help your church explain the gospel clearly and effectively. Share the four symbols that communicate the key message of the gospel:

# EXPLAINING THE GOSPEL

# GOD LOVES YOU



"God created us to be in relationship with Him, and wants us to know His love. But every person has chosen their own path, leading to separation from God."

# SEPARATION FROM GOD



"Our decisions have consequences. Sin separates us from God, and this brokenness is felt in the world around us."

# JESUS GAVE EVERYTHING FOR YOU



"Though we were lost and separated from God, He sent His Son, Jesus, to take on our sin and guilt, he died on the Cross taking the penalty for our sins. He rose again, offering us forgiveness and new life. So that we can come back into relationship with Him."

# DO YOU WANT TO LIVE FOREVER WITH JESUS?



"Jesus is the way to God, and now it's our choice to accept His offer. Will you invite Him into your life?"



# SHARE & CELEBRATE

## SHARE JESUS ON GO DAY:

Distribute Cards: Hand out cards to your members prior to GO Day. These will provide helpful prompts to get everyone started:

# START A CONVERSATION:

A simple "Hi" is a great way to start a conversation.

## SHARE YOUR STORY AND THE GOSPEL:

Ask, "What's the best thing that's ever happened to you?" to bridge into your message.

# END THE CONVERSATION:

If the person is ready to receive Jesus, great! If not, pray for them, say goodbye, and keep going! God is at work.

## **CELEBRATE:**

Follow up with your congregation to celebrate what God has done. Share the stories with us.
